#### Notes for the editor

- Community Foundations of NZ is the national body supporting and uniting the collective of independent Community Foundations (17) across NZ
- Community Foundations are different for NZ's Community Trusts; they raise funds from donations and bequests and invest them in perpetuity (forever) in managed endowment funds. Many also provide a structure for enabling funding for community projects and initiatives.
- Income from invested funds is distributed as community grants for charitable purposes.
- Across the NZ network Community Foundations, in partnership with generous locals, have grown endowment funds to over \$150m, and have a further estimated \$350m+ promised in bequests
- Since 2014 Community Foundations have granted over \$50m to NZ communities
- The Tindall Foundation supports the work of Community Foundations of NZ growing generosity across Aotearoa NZ
